Having survived ethnic violence as a child, I have a desire to give back. I lead 2-3 international humanitarian medical trips each year with Healing the Children North East to help children with facial deformities, and have been doing so since 2002 aside from a 1.5 year pause during the Covid pandemic. I am on the Board of Healing the Children North East and sit on the Medical Advisory Committee. More recently, as past Chair and now Senior Advisor of FACE TO FACE, the humanitarian arm of the American Academy of Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery, I have led three medical missions to Ukraine to treat patients with devastating facial injuries from the war. We have brought many Ukrainian surgeons to the United States to provide advanced training in microvascular reconstruction and other techniques so that they can operate independently and take care of patients when they return to Ukraine. I have also led efforts with the Facial Plastic Surgery Academy and with the National Coalition Against Domestic Violence and Break The Silence Foundation to treat patients who are victims of domestic abuse. I have been recognized for my humanitarian work with many awards, including the Healing Hearts Leadership Award by Healing The Children North East, the Westchester Magazine's Healthcare Heroes Award for the second time last year, and most recently the Medal for the Order of Saint Panteleimon for professionalism and mercy by the Honorable Council in Ukraine, as well as

Special Distinction in Global Surgery by the American Academy of Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery.

TEACHING

I immensely enjoy teaching to advance our field and mentor the next generation. I have been involved with teaching since the inception of my career. I currently teach resident physicians and medical students, and mentor those interested in Facial Plastic Surgery. I have had the privilege of being appointed to the Facial Plastic Surgery fellowship faculty at Mt. Sinai in 2020 and I am now Co-Director of the fellowship program. I have been invited to lecture locally, nationally, and internationally, and have organized several meetings including as Program Chair for the American Academy of Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery's Annual Spring meeting in 2023. I also have the opportunity to teach on international medical mission trips all over the world. Most recently, as Chair and then Senior Advisor of FACE TO FACE, the humanitarian arm of the American Academy of Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery, I organized efforts to train Ukrainian surgeons on complex reconstructive techniques including microvascular free flap reconstruction and design and placement of custom patient specific 3-Dimensional implants to reconstruct complex facial defects. My team was able to provide onsite training in the operating room and with live streamed procedures during three recent medical mission trips to Ukraine. We have also brought Ukrainian surgeons to the United States to allow shadowing, mentoring, and training on these complex reconstructive procedures.
